Mr. Koehler is an Associate Director in Berkeley Research Group's international Energy and Natural Resources practice. For over seven years he has provided strategic advice and guidance to institutional investors involving issues across the energy value-chain, including utilities and power generation, cleantech integration, oil and gas production, LNG, transportation, biofuels, efficiency, and carbon regulation. He is a senior member of Berkeley Research Group's expert team analyzing markets, financing, and risk for global energy projects and provides strategic, economic, and commercial advice to guide developers and investors through an increasingly complex and competitive global energy marketplace - including new considerations surrounding the imperatives of climate change, environmental stewardship, and privatization.

Concurrently Mr. Koehler serves as Professor of Practice at Georgetown University, where he teaches a graduate-level course covering energy structure and markets to students from both the School of Foreign Service and School of Business.

Mr. Koehler is currently serving a one-year term as president of the U.S. Association for Energy Economics – National Capital Area Chapter (USAEE-NCAC), where he leads a professional organization of 300 members and 13 Board members. He is also a Fellow with the Truman National Security Project where he co-chairs the Energy and Environment Expert Group, focusing on issues surrounding energy, climate, and national security.

Mr. Koehler has been featured in major media outlets and spoken at finance, trade, and university conferences in the United States and around the world.

He began his career as a senior advisor in the United States Senate to Ken Salazar (D-CO) and previously worked under former Secretary of State Madeleine Albright. He is a graduate of Boston College and Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service.
